STEERING COMMITTEE MINUTES

JUNE 18, 1991

Steering Committee Meeting was held at Valley Region Headquarters on Tuesday, June 18, 1991 at 7:00pm.

The steering committee was made aware of the Regional Water Quality Control Board's request for an amendment to the Lake Management plan due to the proposed charges in delivery amounts and residency time, and will review the department's request for a NPDES permit after the amendment is submitted.

Steve Hartman, California Native Plant Society, suggested the Department of Recreation and Parks establish a selective weed eradication program in the riparian corridor running east to west adjacent to Hjelte Fields.

A vegetation plan was requested for the Wildlife Lake showing areas to be planted with emergent vegetation and their types.

The Department has been requested to continue to irrigate the oaks on the slope of Burbank Boulevard; San Fernando section of the Wildlife Reserve.

The California Native Plant Society requests that the Department of Recreation and Parks remove the Arundo from Bull Creek.

The steering committee members request that the Department of Recreation and Parks provide them with a copy of the original contract dealing with construction of the Wildlife Reserve.

Attached is a copy of the people attending this meeting.
